Summit Times

Badges

You will receive a Summit folder upon check-in at the hotel. Included in this package is your Summit badge. Summit Folders

Summit folders will be available for all participants to pick up in the hotel lobby starting on Thursday from 3-9pm and on the first day of the Summit beginning at 7:00am. Seating

There is no reserved seating. Attendees are seated on a "first come, first served" basis.
